

Author guideline: news

What is a news item?

- A news item presents a recent scientific, political, technical or other development within the field of physical therapy.

Content

- A news item consists of a maximum of 750 words

Components

- Title: short, informative and containing the most relevant keywords.
- Personal information: name, title, academic qualifications, profession
- Scientific: who (research group / funds / other parties), when and where this scientific research took place. Describe method and conclusion of relevance for health care and/or physical therapy
- Political / technical: description of who (with which funds / parties), when and where this development took place and their conclusion of relevance for health care and/or physical therapy.
- News sources or scientific article as reference(s)

Layout

- Font style: Tahoma 9 punts. Bold for components in the article.
- Alignment: left
- Spacing: single
- Abbreviations: the first time you use an abbreviation in the text, present both the spelled-out version and the short form.

References

- One or more news sources or scientific article as reference (APA or Vancouver method)
